*"All fees, including registration, late and t-shirt fees, will be counted toward the enforcement of this policy."*

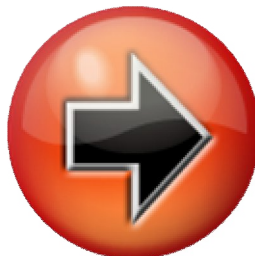
