Registration Reminders

Registration for delegates arriving on time will be at the Edgewater Resort and Waterpark, Hotel and Conference Center between 1:00 P.M.—6:30 P.M. Please send only the NCC and advisor into the Hotel to register. Registration will take place in the secondary lobby on the side facing to the East. While registration opens at 1:00 PM, the hotel will not have rooms ready right away. We will work with the hotel to get into the rooms as soon as possible.

For arrivals after 6:30 PM, we will be moving the registration up to the Mitchell Auditorium on our campus. Late registration will be open at 7:00 P.M. in the Mitchell. Please refer to the website if you feel that there may be a possibility that you will be late for directions to Mitchell Auditorium from the hotel. Out of respect for the conference, PLEASE PLAN ARRIVE ON TIME (EARLY IS BETTER)!

Please note that at registration, we will be asking for your license plate numbers. Please have

them ready. They will be needed to ensure that you are not ticketed on our campus by our Security and also for the hotel's security.

General Frills 2009 will adhere to the "No Pay, No Key" policy mentioned in the previous newsletters. This policy means that should a school's delegation fail to pay the registration fees, the late fees, or the t-shirt fees, they will not be allowed access to their rooms at the hotel. This is according to regional policy and no exceptions will be taken. Please plan to bring them to the conference. This is to avoid lost payment in the mail. We no longer have a pay online option; we will be accepting checks only at this point. It is also acceptable to pay in one large sum to avoid multiple checks.

Also Delegate/Advisor waivers must be turned in at Registration. In return, your school will receive any t-shirts ordered, conference folders with conference schedule, nametags, hotel room keys, maps, and any additional regional materials.

Directions from Hotel to Campus

To get from the Resort to the campus leave the resort and take a left onto London Rd. Turn right onto 21st Ave. E. at the first set of stop lights. Drive up the hill to Woodland Ave. and turn right on to Woodland. Follow Woodland Ave. to West College Street. Turn left on College Street (it is the first left after the first set of stop lights on Woodland Ave). Follow College Street past the University of Minnesota – Duluth on your right. At the end

of College Street is the entrance to The College of St. Scholastica. Parking will be available in lots # 8 or 13, located near the Science Building, towards the left. These parking lots will be denoted with a sign.
